



CHANGES IN AUGUST

THE DOOR-TO-DOOR WASTE COLLECTION IS STARTING IN PISOgne, GRATACASOLO AND TOLINE

Door to door waste collection is starting for resident families in Pisogne, Gratacasolo and Toline (district 1). Street bins will be eliminated and substituted with special bags and bins for waste collection at home. Starting August 1st, each user will separate (at home) waste into the containers provided and put them out to be collected **only on the days indicated**.

 <p>GLASS, METAL AND ALUMINIUM</p>	 <p>single homes</p>  <p>blocks of flats</p> <p>→ door to door weekly collection FRIDAY</p>	<p>YES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • empty bottles, jars, drinking glasses, glasses, glass containers and objects • empty containers and cans made of aluminium, metal (tuna fish, peeled tomatoes, etc.) • metal bottle tops • aluminium tubes • aluminium food trays and films <p>NO</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • light bulbs and neon lights • ceramics (broken plates etc.)
 <p>NON-RECYCLABLE SOLID WASTE</p>	 <p>single homes</p>  <p>blocks of flats</p> <p>→ door to door weekly collection WEDNESDAY</p>	<p>YES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • rubber, toys • CDs, audio and video cassettes • plastic plates, beakers and cutlery • carbon, greaseproof and plasticized paper • ceramic shards, light bulbs • sanitary towels, pads and babies' nappies • cosmetics, dirty rags • coffee pods, cigarette ends • vacuum dusts <p>NO</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • all recyclable waste

NOTE: bags and bins have to be put on the edge of the street, outside the home/place of business by 6 am on collection day (after 7 pm the evening before).

DOMESTIC COMPOSTING

Domestic composting is a natural process for **re-cycling organic & vegetable waste** at home. If kept in a composter for a few months, it becomes **quality compost** to use as a natural fertilizer in vegetable gardens/gardens and on potted plants. It's **important to alternate** kitchen (peels, food bits, coffee filters, etc.) and garden waste (leaves, trimmings, branches, etc.).

The composter should be positioned on the ground/lawn.

Only people with a vegetable garden/garden can carry out domestic composting.



People interested in domestic composting can request a **free composter** by calling LA BI.CO due's freephone number.

Families residing where the **door to door service has been activated** (Pisogne, Gratacasolo and Toline), participating in domestic composting and requesting a composter **decline door to door collection of moist organic waste.**

GREEN SERVICE

Families with a vegetable garden/garden not participating in domestic composting may put garden waste, twigs, large quantities of vegetable waste, etc. in the **green service containers** located in the district.



ENVIRONMENT COUNTER

An environmental agent is available to:

- provide correct info on collection methods
- collect info on problems and issues
- book bins for blocks of flats, composters, nappy containers
- provide info on the service
- assess special situations

OPENING DAYS AND TIMES

The counter is open **Saturday morning** from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm at the Municipal Offices (ICI counter) - Via Vallecamonica 2 - Pisogne, from **Sat. July 31st 2010** to **Sat. January 22nd 2011** (excluding December 25th and January 1st).

MISC. COLLECTION SERVICES

Pending activation of the Municipal Waste Disposal Centre, special collection services are provided for waste not included in door to door collection.

WASTE	COLLECTION
WEEE (household appliances, mobile phones, computers, monitors, etc.). Bulky waste (furniture, mattresses, sofas, demijohns, etc.).	Door to door collection 3rd Thursday of month for requests c/o LA BI.CO due's freephone number 3 days prior. Put on edge of street (do not obstruct passage) by 7 am on collection day.
Dangerous waste (toners, cartridges, used car batteries, mineral & vegetable oils, "T" & "F" containers, sprays, paints, solvents, neon lights, etc.).	Limited door to door collection 4th Thursday of month . A special lorry will stop along the main roads to collect this waste.
Wood, tyres, large quantities of metal	On-street collection 3rd Thursday of month in special containers in district, available for 24 hours starting at 6 am on day indicated.
Garden waste, twigs, large quantities of garden vegetable waste, etc.	On-street collection in permanent green service containers . Put out loose items or material tied with string.
Used batteries, out of date medicines	On-street collection in special containers in front of retailers and chemist's shops.

NAPPY SERVICE

Special service dedicated to all families with children (aged 0-3), elderly members or sick people; they may use LA BI.CO due's freephone number to book and purchase a special odourless container to gather nappies for several days.
